The event will take place from 10.30am to 10.30pm on 8th March 2005. This is an opportunity for women to network, sample yoga sessions and complimentary Therapy as well as receive information about services. They can also take part in workshops on Drug and Alcohol Education and self empowerment.

The DAAP Woman of the Year Award will be presented in the evening and there are a number of local and national speakers. Music and food will round off the celebrations
