- One day interactive workshops for young people between the ages of 13 years to 17 years at Coldingley, Lewes and Send prisons where prisoners facilitate the sessions as part of the Keep Out scheme
- Crime awareness sessions for young people in schools, youth clubs and in community settings delivered by DAAP staff and volunteers
- Learning and creative opportunities in the community for young people up to the age of 25 years organised by DAAP
- Drug, alcohol and Khat awareness sessions for young people in all settings
